Online Experience:	Our virtual programs go far beyond just replicating PowerPoint presentations online: these programs are intentionally designed to give you the kind of robust and dynamic learning experience you expect. In our programs you will be able can explore new ideas and re- discover old ones, and understand a wide range of possibilities around a topic. Overview:	The 4-week Academic English Program is aimed at developing academic listening, speaking, reading and writing skills for intermediate-advanced level (B2) students. Learner outcomes include general academic vocabulary development, listening skill improvement in an academic setting, development of effective note-taking skills, improved academic discussion and presentation skills, improvement in reading and comprehension of university textbook materials, magazine articles, and on-line/library materials, and development of academic essay and research paper writing skills. Students build skills through practice with materials that use authentic academic content-based lectures. Students read and present material both verbally and in writing, and write essays.
	This course will use blended delivery online, and will utilize electronic resources and materials that will be provided during lessons. The class will run from 10am to 1:00pm (Canada- Eastern Time), Monday to Thursday (Guadalajara time: 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m) Class attendance is mandatory and students' active participation will be crucial to the successful completion of this course. The class will connect online via Zoom meetings for three hours with opportunities for independent work built-in those three hours. All course information will be provided on the class' D2L site. This is also where students will submit assignments, complete discussions and write assessment tasks.
