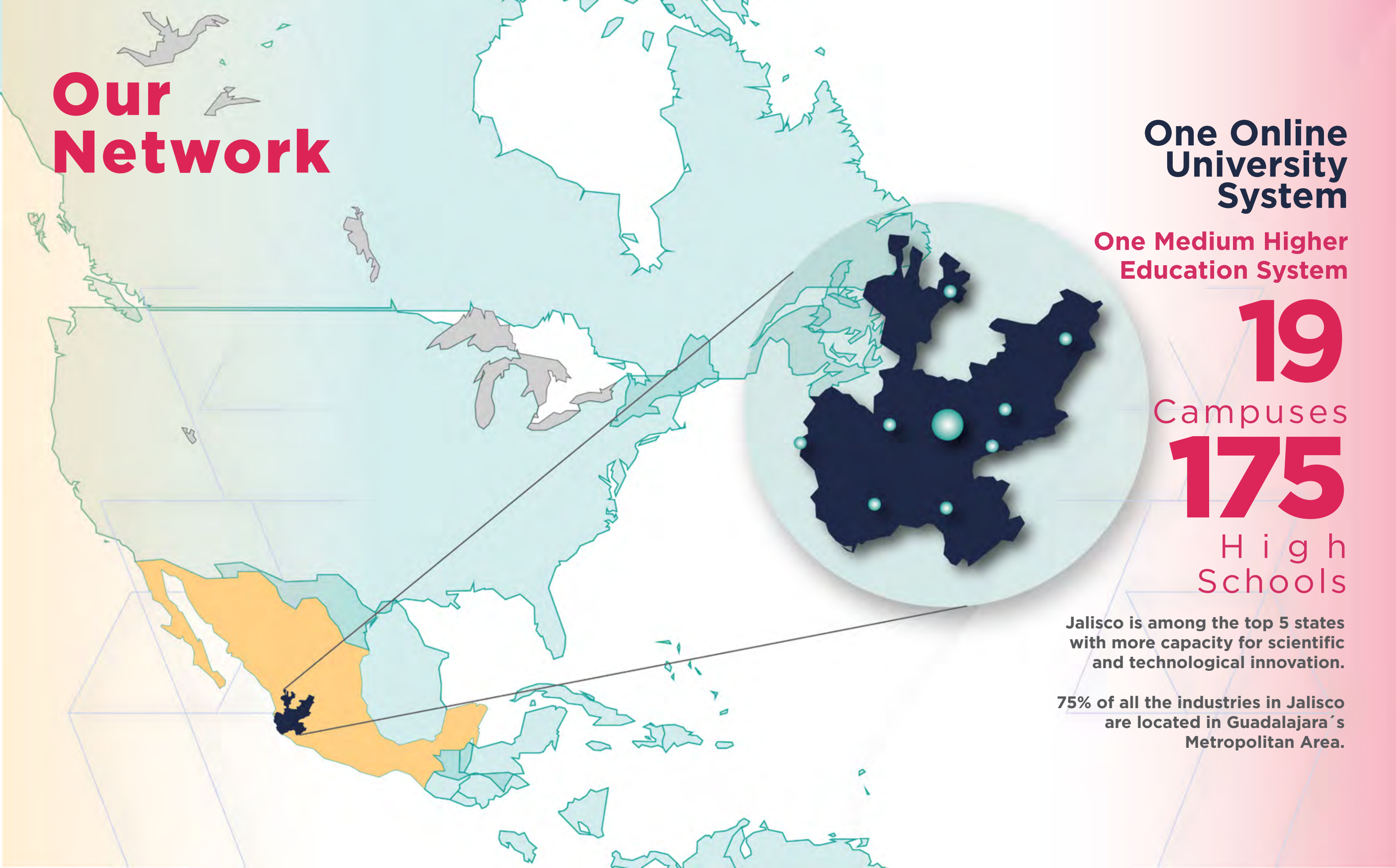

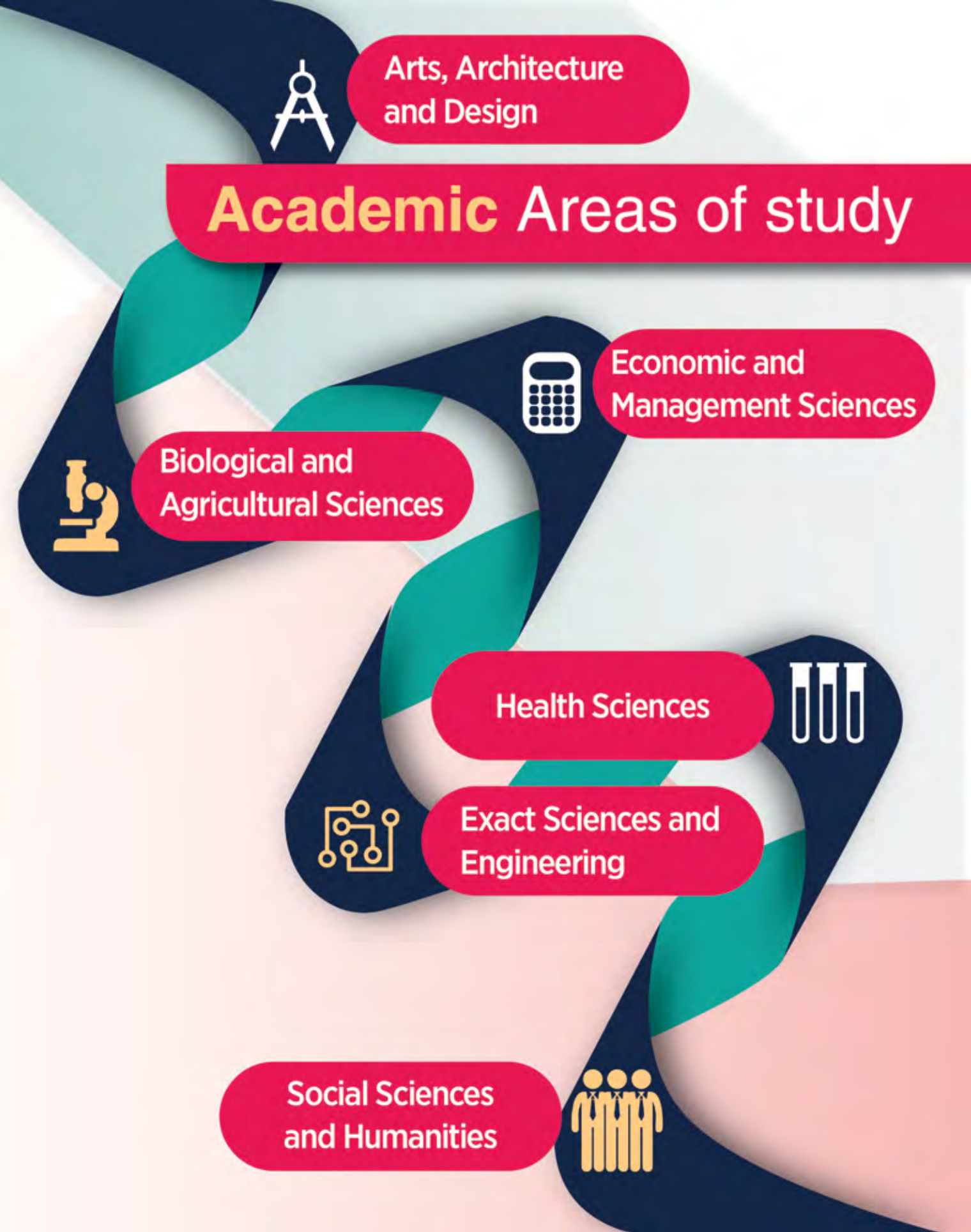
Our Network
